ORGANIZATION OF THE COMMITTEE'S WORK

The CHAIRMAN welcomed the representative of Burma, U Kyaw Min and the representative of Guatemala, Mr. Urrutia Aparicio, who were attending the Committee for the first time, as well as Mr. Chacko, the new Secretary of the Committee. He said that during the twenty-second session of the Trusteeship Council the Standing Committee on Administrative Unions would consider the administrative union affecting New Guinea. For that purpose, he proposed that the Special Representative of the Administering Authority for that Territory should participate in the Committee's next meeting, which might be held about the middle of the following week. The Committee would probably not have to meet more than twice after having heard the Special Representative.

Mr. FELD (United States of America) supported the Chairman's suggestion and hoped that arrangements would be made to ensure that the next one or two meetings of the Committee did not conflict with the Council's meetings since he had to be present at the Council sessions the following week.

The CHAIRMAN suggested that the Secretary of the Committee should settle the matter in consultation with the Special Representative.
