ITINERARY FOR SECRETARY-GENERAL'S VISITS TO MEMBER COUNTRIES

Secretary-General Dag Hammarskjold will leave on Wednesday, 27 June, for official visits to member countries in Central and Eastern Europe and for meetings of the Administrative Committee on Co-ordination and the Economic and Social Council at Geneva.

He will be accompanied by Lennart Finnmark, Personal Assistant and Chief of the General Assembly Affairs Section in the Executive Office of the Secretary-General, and William Ranallo, Personal Aide.

Ilya Tchernychev, Under-Secretary, will join the Secretary-General in Moscow and accompany him to Prague. Dragoslav Protitch, Under-Secretary for Political and Security Council Affairs, will join the Secretary-General for the Vienna-Belgrade portion of the trip.
