Note by the Secretary-General*

The Human Rights Council, in paragraph 12 of its resolution 48/1, adopted on 7 October 2021, decided to appoint, for a period of one year, a special rapporteur to monitor the situation of human rights as it develops in Afghanistan, with the mandate to, among others, present a report to the Council at its fifty-first session and to the General Assembly at its seventy-seventh session, in accordance with their respective programmes of work. The Special Rapporteur on the situation of human rights in Afghanistan, who assumed his functions in May 2022, will present to the Assembly the report that he presented to the Council at its fifty-first session, contained in document A/HRC/51/6, together with an oral update.
