Letter dated 1 December 1982 from Mr. Nail Atalay to
the Secretary-General

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to refer to the letter dated 23 November 1982 from Mr. Constantine Moushoutas, representative of the Greek Cypriot administration, which was circulated on 24 November 1982 as a United Nations document (A/37/642-S/15499).

The military exercises of 19 November 1982 that took place in the territory of the Turkish Federated State of Kibris were the routine exercises of the Turkish Peace Force and were carried out in accordance with a scheduled programme, about which prior notification was provided to the authorities of the United Nations Peace-Keeping Force in Cyprus. Therefore, the allegation by Mr. Moushoutas concerning the violation of the airspace of the Greek Cypriot administration on 19 November 1982 deserves no reply.
