Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution [1718 \(2006\)](#)

Note verbale dated 31 October 2022 from the Permanent Mission of Türkiye to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Türkiye to the United Nations, with reference to its note verbale dated 16 March 2021, has the honour to inform the Committee of the most recent measures taken by the Republic of Türkiye in order to effectively implement Security Council resolution [1718 \(2006\)](#) and the Council's relevant subsequent resolutions concerning the sanctions regime on the Democratic People's Republic of Korea.

In line with the amendments enacted by the Committee on 30 June 2022, 26 July 2022 and 14 September 2022 on its sanctions list of individuals and entities, two separate presidential decrees (Decree No. 5967 and Decree No. 6220) were issued by the Republic of Türkiye, which took effect upon their publication in the Official Gazette on 13 August 2022 and 19 October 2022, respectively.

The aforementioned presidential decrees were issued in accordance with the Law on the Prevention of the Financing of Proliferation of Weapons of Mass Destruction (Law No. 7262), which has been in force in Türkiye since 31 December 2020. Law No. 7262 sets up the procedures and principles regarding the implementation of the sanctions established by the Security Council resolutions in the field of prevention of the financing of proliferation of weapons of mass destruction.

With the publication of these latest presidential decrees, the Turkish national legislation has been brought up to date, in line with the current version of the Security Council's sanctions list of individuals and entities.

The Republic of Türkiye reiterates its determination to support the full and effective implementation of the United Nations sanctions regarding the Democratic People's Republic of Korea.
