DRAFT STANDARD RULES OF PROCEDURE FOR UNITED NATIONS CONFERENCES

Report of the Sixth Committee

Rapporteur: Miss Salwa Gabriel BERBERI (Sudan)

1. The item "Draft standard rules of procedure for United Nations conferences: report of the Secretary-General" was included in the provisional agenda of the thirty-seventh session of the General Assembly pursuant to Assembly decision 36/427 of 10 December 1981. On the recommendation of the General Committee, the General Assembly decided at its 4th plenary meeting, on 24 September 1982, to include the item in its agenda and to allocate it to the Sixth Committee.
2. In connection with this item, the Sixth Committee had before it a report of the Secretary-General (A/37/163) submitted in response to General Assembly resolution 35/10 of 3 November 1980, as well as a supplementary report (A/C.6/37/5).
3. At its 67th meeting, on 10 December 1982, the Sixth Committee adopted, by consensus, a draft decision as proposed by its Chairman (see para. 4).

RECOMMENDATION OF THE SIXTH COMMITTEE

4. The Sixth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:

Draft standard rules of procedure for United Nations conferences

The General Assembly,

- (a) Decides to defer to its thirty-eighth session consideration of the reports of the Secretary-General on draft standard rules of procedure for United Nations conferences; 1/
- (b) Invites Governments and the international organizations concerned to communicate to the Secretary-General, by 1 May 1983, their observations on the above-mentioned reports;
- (c) Requests the Secretary-General to submit to the General Assembly at its thirty-eighth session a report on draft standard rules of procedure for United Nations conferences.
