SUMMARIES OF PETITIONS AND COMMUNICATIONS CIRCULATED BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL, PURSUANT TO RULES 24 AND 85, PARAGRAPH 2, OF THE RULES OF PROCEDURE

Addendum to the Memorandum by the Secretariat

The present memorandum contains a list of documents circulated since 25 April 1956 by the Secretary-General pursuant to rules 24 and 85, paragraph 2, of the rules of procedure of the Trusteeship Council, which relate exclusively to the Togoland unification problem and the future of Togoland under British administration.

The present memorandum supersedes sections 81 to 87 and 92 to 103, inclusive, of document T/C.2/L.265 and covers those petitions and communications related to that subject in the light of the action taken by the Trusteeship Council during its sixth special session and by the General Assembly during its eleventh session.

Togoland under British administration

1. T/PET.6/L.68-87

These petitions which relate to the Togoland unification problem and the future of Togoland under British administration were brought to the attention of the Fourth Committee during the eleventh session of the General Assembly when it discussed this question.

Togoland under British administration and Togoland under French administration

2. T/PET.6 and 7/L.49-96

These petitions, which relate to the Togoland unification problem and the future of Togoland under British administration, were brought to the attention of the Trusteeship Council during its sixth special session, at which time it decided to include a list of these petitions in annex IV of its special report to the General Assembly (A/3169/Add.1).

3. T/PET.6 and 7/L.97-100

The above petitions, raising similar questions as those listed under paragraph 2 above, were circulated subsequent to the discussions of the Togoland unification problem by the Council and by the General Assembly. It is therefore suggested that the Standing Committee on Petitions recommend to the Trusteeship Council that these petitions should be taken into consideration when next it considers the future of Togoland under French administration.

Togoland under French administration

4. T/PET.7/L.15-30, T/COM.7/L.39 and T/COM.7/L.40

These petitions and communications relating to the future of Togoland under French administration were brought to the attention of the Trusteeship Council during its sixth special session, at which time it decided to include a list of these petitions and communications in annex IV of its special report to the General Assembly (A/3169/Add.1).
