QUESTION OF THE COMPOSITION OF THE RELEVANT ORGANS
OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Report of the Special Political Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Faruk LOGOGLU (Turkey)

1. The item entitled "Question of the composition of the relevant organs of the United Nations" was included in the provisional agenda of the thirty-seventh session of the General Assembly in accordance with Assembly decision 36/433 of 16 December 1981.
2. At its 4th plenary meeting, on 24 September 1982, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include the item in its agenda and to allocate it to the Special Political Committee.
3. At the 46th meeting of the Special Political Committee, on 7 December, the Chairman proposed that, as no member of the Committee had requested to speak on the item, consideration of it should be deferred until the thirty-eighth session.
4. In the absence of any objection, it was so decided.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE SPECIAL POLITICAL COMMITTEE

5. The Special Political Committee recommends that the General Assembly should include in the provisional agenda of its thirty-eighth session the item entitled "Question of the composition of the relevant organs of the United Nations".
