Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 61st meeting, on 9 December 1982, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/37/77) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution II recommended by the Special Political Committee in paragraph 18 of its report (A/37/646). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/37/SR.61).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by 80 votes to 12, with 3 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution II recommended by the Special Political Committee in paragraph 18 of its report (A/37/646), an additional appropriation of \$34,900 would be required under section 2 of the programme budget for 1982-1983. Provision of \$10,000 would also have to be made under section 31 (Staff assessment), to be offset by an increase in the same amount under Income section 1 (Income from staff assessment).
4. Statements in explanation of vote were made by representatives of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America.
