Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 61st meeting, on 9 December 1982, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/37/81) on the administrative and financial implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Sixth Committee in paragraph 11 of its report (A/37/720). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/37/SR.61).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by 64 votes to 7, with 21 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the Sixth Committee in paragraph 11 of its report (A/37/720), an additional appropriation of \$127,400 would be required under section 26 of the programme budget for the biennium 1982-1983.
4. A statement in explanation of vote was made by the representative of Canada.
