Note verbale dated 9 December 1982 from the Permanent Representative of Senegal to the United Nations addressed to the President of the General Assembly

The Permanent Representative of the Republic of Senegal to the United Nations presents his compliments to the President of the thirty-seventh session of the General Assembly and has the honour to inform him, in accordance with the decision of the Group of African States set forth in document A/37/91 of 19 February 1982, that Togo is a candidate for the seat that will become vacant in 1983 following the withdrawal of Senegal from the Ad Hoc Committee on the Drafting of an International Convention against the Recruitment, Use, Financing and Training of Mercenaries, on the understanding that Senegal will be a candidate to replace Nigeria on the Ad Hoc Committee in 1984.
