GHANA PLEDGES VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION TO HELP UNITED NATIONS  
OVERCOME FINANCIAL DIFFICULTIES

At a meeting with the Secretary-General today, Alex Quaison-Sackey, President of the nineteenth session of the General Assembly, informed the Secretary-General that it was the intention of the Government of Ghana to make an unconditional voluntary contribution of \$20,000 to the United Nations to help overcome its financial difficulties.

The Secretary-General expressed his deepest appreciation to Mr. Quaison-Sackey and requested that his gratitude be conveyed to the President of Ghana, Kwame Nkrumah.
