#### Report of the Fifth Committee

At its 66th meeting, on 13 December 1982, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to 1. rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statements by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/37/89 and A/C.5/37/88) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolutions C and I recommended by the Special Political Committee in paragraph 41 of its report (A/37/723). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.

Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of 2. this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/37/SR.66).

#### DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

#### University of Jerusalem for Palestine refugees (draft resolution C) Α.

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by 84 votes to 2, with 8 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution C recommended by the Special Political Committee in paragraph 41 of its report (A/37/723), an additional appropriation of \$110,000 would be required under section 1 of the programme budget for the biennium 1982-1983.

# B. Special identification cards to all Palestine refugees (draft resolution I)

4. The Fifth Committee decided, by a recorded vote of 59 to 9, with 15 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution I recommended by the Special Political Committee in paragraph 41 of its report (A/37/723), an additional appropriation of \$40,000 would be required under section 1 of the programme budget for the biennium 1982-1983.
