Structured dialogue on financing

In accordance with UN-Women Executive Board decisions on the structured dialogue on financing, the most recent being [2021/8](#), this report includes elements of an ongoing dialogue on financing the results of the UN Women Strategic Plan, with the overall objective that the Executive Board-endorsed integrated budgets are fully financed in support of the comprehensive implementation of the UN-Women Strategic Plan.

This report takes into account previous recommendations to improve the quality of structured dialogues and reflects harmonized approaches to dialogues and Funding Compact reporting among the United Nations Development Programme, the United Nations Population Fund, the United Nations Children’s Fund and UN-Women, including the potential impacts of multiple complex crises on financing for development.
