Land violations committed in February 2023

<i>Date</i>	<i>Time</i>	<i>Nature of violation</i>
1 February		In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Mays al-Jabal, the Kurum al-Shirazi area and points B64/1 and B65, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory.
2 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated at follows: 4 in Naqurah.
	0120	In occupied Palestinian territory at the Israeli enemy Shatula position, enemy soldiers fired a flare that violated Lebanese airspace by a distance of about 300 m.
3 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated at follows: 14 in Naqurah.
	0900	In occupied territory, opposite the town of Wazzani at the Israeli enemy Humayri position, personnel in military uniform approached. They shouted at farmers located on the Lebanese side and pointed their weapons in the direction of Lebanese territory.
5 February	2000	Opposite Ras al-Naqurah, inside occupied Lebanese territory north of the withdrawal line (the Blue Line with respect to which Lebanon maintains reservations), northeast of point B1, enemy Israeli personnel installed two searchlights. One was pointed towards Lebanese territorial waters and the other towards Lebanese territory.
8 February	2022	In the occupied Shab'a Farms, the Israeli enemy fired two flares over the Israeli enemy Radar position.
9 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated at follows: 9 in Naqurah.
	1600	Explosions of unknown origin were heard from inside the occupied Shab'a Farms.
10 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated at follows: 2 in Naqurah.
12 February	0830	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the town of Ghajar, the Israeli enemy completed bulldozing work along the road from opposite the Wazzani pump towards the SD1 road. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1600 hours.
13 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 15 in Naqurah, 25 in Amra, 11 in Marwahin and 14 in Duhayrah.

	0800	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite points BP17(1) and B42, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed their weapons and the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory and two Lebanese Army patrols.
	0830	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the town of Ghajar, the Israeli enemy finished levelling the new road outside the technical fence in the direction of point SD1 and reinforced it by setting up wood frames on both sides of the road, fitting them with metal rods, and pouring concrete over them.
14 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated at follows: 4 in Naqurah.
	1000	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the town of Ghajar, the Israeli enemy finished levelling the new road outside the technical fence in the direction of point SD1. They removed the wood frames set up previously.
15 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 16 in Naqurah, 8 in Amra and 7 in Duhayrah.
	0800	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the town of Ghajar, the Israeli enemy finished levelling the new road outside the technical fence in the direction of point SD1 and reinforced it by setting up wood frames on both sides of the road, fitting them with metal rods, and pouring concrete over them.
	1030	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite Sahl al-Khiyam near point B90, an Israeli enemy group consisting of 25 individuals in civilian clothing approached. They scouted the area and photographed the Lebanese side. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1200 hours.
16 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 8 in Duhayrah, 35 in Marwahin and 2 in Yarun.
	0800	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the town of Ghajar, the Israeli enemy finished levelling the new road outside the technical fence in the direction of point SD1. They removed the wood frames set up previously.
17 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 17 in Yarun, 8 in Duhayrah, 20 in Marwahin, 16 in Amrah, 7 in Hula and 12 in Naqurah.
18 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated at follows: 15 in Duhayrah.

19 February	0830	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the town of Ghajar, the Israeli enemy finished levelling the new road outside the technical fence in the direction of point SD1 and reinforced it by setting up wood frames on both sides of the road, fitting them with metal rods, and pouring concrete over them.
20 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 14 in Naqurah, 8 in Duhayrah, 9 in Marwahin, 22 in Amra and 8 in Yarun.
	–	In occupied Lebanese territory south of the withdrawal line (the Blue Line with respect to which Lebanon maintains reservations) on the outskirts of the town of Alma al-Sha'b, the Israeli enemy carried out excavation work using a bulldozer and a truck in preparation for the construction of a concrete separation wall.
	0820	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the town of Ghajar, the Israeli enemy finished levelling the new road outside the technical fence in the direction of point SD1 and reinforced it by setting up wood frames on both sides of the road, fitting them with metal rods, and pouring concrete over them.
21 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 10 in Yarun, 15 in Amra, 10 in Arab al-Luwayzah, 13 in Hula, 15 in Duhayrah and 12 in Naqurah.
	0730	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Aytarun at points B52(2) and BP23, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of a D9 bulldozer, an excavator, a personnel carrier, a civilian pickup, a van, a military pickup and two Merkava tanks with their cannons pointed towards Lebanese territory approached. Some 20 personnel in military uniform approached and deployed behind the earthen berms. They pointed their weapons at Lebanese army personnel. The bulldozer worked on clearing brush and erecting an earthen berm about 40 m long and 3 m high between the technical fence and the withdrawal line (the Blue Line). The bulldozer's arm crossed the withdrawal line while cutting two trees opposite points B52(1) and B52(2). The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1500 hours.
	0830	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the town of Ghajar, the Israeli enemy finished levelling the new road outside the technical fence in the direction of point SD1 and reinforced it by setting up wood frames on both sides of the road, fitting them with metal rods, and pouring concrete over them.
	0900	In the occupied Shab'a Farms, on the outskirts of the town of Kafr Shuba (Mazra'at Bastara), some 33 Israeli enemy personnel conducted a foot patrol from the Zabdin barracks to the entrance to Mazra'at Bastara, where the concrete blocks are located. They then moved on towards Wadi Maghar Shab'a to the vicinity of observation point OP6 of the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL) Indian contingent. Two of the personnel violated the withdrawal line (the Blue Line with respect to which Lebanon maintains reservations) by about 15 m, and then fired

		several bursts in the direction of Lebanese territory. A Merkava tank and a troop carrier deployed in the area around the Fashkul position, and a Merkava tank behind the berm at the entrance to Mazra'at Bastar. Vehicles were seen moving on the road between the Zabdin barracks and the Fashkul position, escorted by a circling reconnaissance aircraft and two helicopters. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1310 hours.
	1000	In occupied Lebanese territory, on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the town of Ghajar, an enemy group consisting of 50 individuals in civilian clothing approached. They scouted the area and photographed the Lebanese side. They left in the direction of occupied territory at 1050 hours.
	1130	In occupied Lebanese territory south of the withdrawal line (the Blue Line with respect to which Lebanon maintains reservations) on the outskirts of the town of Alma al-Sha'b, the Israeli enemy completed excavation work with a bulldozer and a truck, from point B13 to about 30 m east of point BP5. The enemy completed the excavation work with an excavator and a truck in preparation for the construction of a concrete separation wall.
22 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 9 in Naqurah, 9 in Duhayrah, 7 in Marwahin, 24 in Amra and 3 in Yarun.
	–	In occupied Lebanese territory, south of the withdrawal line (the Blue Line with respect to which Lebanon maintains reservations) on the outskirts of the town of Alma al-Sha'b, the Israeli enemy installed concrete blocks extending some 50 m, some of them located inside the occupied Lebanese territory, using a heavy-duty trailer and a truck, with a number of enemy soldiers deployed.
	0015	In the occupied Shab'a Farms, Israeli enemy personnel fired four flares that landed inside Lebanese territory on the outskirts of the town of Kafr Shuba (Mazra'at Bastara), one of which landed on the house of a civilian in Wadi Khansa.
	1030	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Sardah near point B38/2, an Israeli enemy group consisting of 25 individuals in civilian clothing approached. They scouted the area and photographed the Lebanese side. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1100 hours.
	1120	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Aytarun and points B52(2) and BP23, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed a vehicle-mounted machine gun towards Lebanese territory and a Lebanese army patrol.
	1140	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Mays al-Jabal and point BP31, Israeli enemy soldiers pointed the cannon of a Merkava tank towards Lebanese territory.
	1200	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Wazzani at the Israeli enemy Humayri position, an Israeli enemy group consisting of 25 individuals in civilian clothing approached. They scouted the area and photographed the Lebanese side. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1220 hours.

23 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 6 in Yarun, 5 in Amra, 10 in Arab al-Luwayzah, 18 in Duhayrah, 5 in Marwahin, 6 in Naqurah and 3 in Balida.
	0930	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the town of Ghajar, the Israeli enemy finished levelling the new road outside the technical fence in the direction of point SD1 and reinforced it by setting up wood frames on both sides of the road, fitting them with metal rods, and pouring concrete over them.
	1715	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Aytarun at point M6, while a number of civilians were in the vicinity of the withdrawal line, an Israeli enemy patrol approached. One of its personnel threw two percussion grenades to terrorize them. They landed next to the technical fence without injuring anyone.
24 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 14 in Naqurah, 5 in Balida, 11 in Duhayrah and 7 in Yarun.
26 February	0900	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the town of Ghajar, the Israeli enemy finished levelling the new road outside the technical fence in the direction of point SD1 and reinforced it by setting up wood frames on both sides of the road, fitting them with metal rods, and pouring concrete over them.
27 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 10 in Yarun, 29 in Amra, 8 in Hula, 11 in Duhayrah, 14 in Marwahin, 4 in Balida and 15 in Naqurah.
	0800	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the town of Ghajar, the Israeli enemy finished levelling the new road outside the technical fence in the direction of point SD1 and reinforced it by setting up wood frames on both sides of the road, fitting them with metal rods, and pouring concrete over them.
28 February	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 4 in Naqurah, 3 in Duhayrah, 5 in Marwahin, 6 in Amra, 10 in Arab al-Luwayzah, 5 in Mays al-Jabal and 3 in Yarun.
	0800	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Wazzani on the outskirts of the town of Mari, which includes the expanded part of the town of Ghajar, the Israeli enemy finished levelling the new road outside the technical fence in the direction of point SD1 and reinforced it by setting up wood frames on both sides of the road, fitting them with metal rods, and pouring concrete over them.
