NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

At the 90th plenary meeting of its thirty-seventh session, on 3 December 1982, the General Assembly adopted resolution 37/40, entitled "Implementation of the Programme for the Decade for Action to Combat Racism and Racial Discrimination". 1/ In paragraph 8 of that resolution, the General Assembly

"Again requests the Security Council to consider, as a matter of urgency, the imposition of full mandatory sanctions under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations against the racist régime of South Africa and the strengthening of the embargo on arms, with a view to putting an end to all military and nuclear collaboration with South Africa".
