Resolution adopted by the General Assembly on 7 December 2023

78/109. Peremptory norms of general international law (*jus cogens*)

The General Assembly,

Having considered chapter IV of the report of the International Law Commission on the work of its seventy-third session,¹ which contains the draft conclusions on identification and legal consequences of peremptory norms of general international law (*jus cogens*), with their annex,

Taking note of the recommendation of the International Law Commission contained in paragraph 41 of its report,²

Emphasizing the continuing importance of the codification and progressive development of international law, as referred to in Article 13, paragraph 1 (a), of the Charter of the United Nations,

Noting that the subject of identification and legal consequences of peremptory norms of general international law (*jus cogens*) is of major importance in international relations,

1. *Welcomes* the conclusion of the work of the International Law Commission on peremptory norms of general international law (*jus cogens*), and takes note of the adoption by the Commission of the draft conclusions on identification and legal consequences of peremptory norms of general international law (*jus cogens*) and the annex and commentaries thereto;³

2. *Expresses its appreciation* to the International Law Commission for its continuing contribution to the codification and progressive development of international law;

3. *Takes note* of the draft conclusions on identification and legal consequences of peremptory norms of general international law (*jus cogens*) and the annex and commentaries thereto;

4. *Also takes note* of the range of comments and observations on the draft conclusions on identification and legal consequences of peremptory norms of general international law (*jus cogens*) and the annex and commentaries thereto, whether submitted in writing by Governments or expressed in debates of the Sixth Committee,⁴ including those made at the seventy-seventh session of the General Assembly.
