NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

At the 101st plenary meeting of its thirty-seventh session, on 13 December 1982, the General Assembly adopted resolution 37/100, entitled "Review and implementation of the Concluding Document of the Twelfth Special Session of the General Assembly". ^{1/}

In paragraph 2 of resolution 37/100 E, the General Assembly

"Requests the Security Council - and more significantly its permanent members - to proceed with a sense of urgency to the necessary measures for the effective implementation of the decisions of the Council, in accordance with the Charter, for the maintenance of international peace and security."
