NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

At the 108th plenary meeting of its thirty-seventh session, on 16 December 1982, the General Assembly adopted resolution 37/119, entitled "Implementation of the collective security provisions of the Charter of the United Nations for the maintenance of international peace and security". $\underline{1}$ / In paragraph 1 of that resolution, the General Assembly

"<u>Requests</u> the Security Council as a matter of high priority to study the question of implementation of the collective security provisions of the Charter of the United Nations, with a view to strengthening international peace and security, and to report to the General Assembly at its thirty-eighth session".
