EXAMINATION OF CONDITIONS IN THE TRUST TERRITORY OF THE PACIFIC ISLANDS

Union of Soviet Socialist Republics: draft resolution

The Trusteeship Council,

Having considered the report of the United States of America on the administration of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands in 1965-1964,

Having heard the statements of the representatives of the Administering Authority on the situation in the Trust Territory and their replies to questions by members of the Council,

Taking into account the decisions adopted by the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples (A/5800/Add.6) in which inter alia, the inalienable right of the people of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands to self-determination and independence has been reaffirmed,

Noting that the United States of America is refusing to take practical measures directly connected with the implementation of the provisions of the said Declaration and, far from promoting the attainment of independence by the people of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, is in fact trying to preserve for an indefinite period the regime of colonial oppression and exploitation in this Territory and is thus failing to discharge the obligations placed upon it by the Security Council under the Trusteeship Agreement of 2 April 1947,

Noting that, since the approval of the Trusteeship Agreement for the Territory of the Pacific Islands on 2 April 1947, the Security Council has not once examined the situation in that Territory,

Considering that the above-mentioned violations of the principles of the Charter concerning Trust Territories, of the principles proclaimed by the United Nations in the Declaration on the granting of independence to colonial countries and peoples and of the subsequent recommendations of the Special Committee concerning the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands (A/5800/Add.6) require examination by the Security Council,

1. Requests the Security Council to examine the situation in the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands as soon as possible.
