At its 61st meeting, on 9 December 1982, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to the 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the atement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/37/82) on the administrative and nancial implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Sixth Committee paragraph 17 of its report (A/37/722). The recommendations of the Advisory maintee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its mairman.

Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of his item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/37/SR.61).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly nat, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the Sixth Committee in aragraph 17 of its report (A/37/722), conference-servicing costs would arise, hich are estimated, on a full-cost basis, at \$548,700. The actual additional ppropriations that might be required in this respect would be considered in the ontext of the consolidated statement of total conference-servicing requirements to e submitted to the General Assembly at a later stage during the current session.
