At its 61st meeting, on 9 December 1982, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/37/82) on the administrative and financial implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Sixth Committee in paragraph 17 of its report (A/37/722). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.

Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/37/SR.61).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the Sixth Committee in paragraph 17 of its report (A/37/722), conference-servicing costs would arise, which are estimated, on a full-cost basis, at \$548,700. The actual additional appropriations that might be required in this respect would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of total conference-servicing requirements to be submitted to the General Assembly at a later stage during the current session.
