## STATEMENT

## BY VIET NAM NEWS AGENCY

According to a news report from Radio Australia of December 16, 1982 Thailand had sent to the Secretary General of the United Nations Organization a note slanderously accusing Vietnamese troops of numerous incursions into Thai territory during last October.

Viet Nam News Agency is authorized to completely reject the above-said fabrication. As was pointed out more than once by Viet Nam News Agency, such fabrications are intended to poison the atmosphere of dialogue and to undermine the restoration of friendly relations between Viet Nam and Thailand, and only serve the Beijing expansionists and hegemonists' scheme of continuing to provoke confrontation between the Indochinese and ASEAN countries.
