ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE DISPATCH OF A VISITING MISSION TO OBSERVE THE
PLEBISCITE IN THE MARIANA ISLANDS DISTRICT OF THE TRUST TERRITORY
OF THE PACIFIC ISLANDS, JUNE 1975

Draft resolution

The Trusteeship Council,

Aware of the plebiscite to be held in the Mariana Islands District of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands on 17 June 1975,

Having been invited by the Administering Authority to dispatch a mission to observe the plebiscite, 1/

1. Decides to send a Visiting Mission to observe the plebiscite in the Mariana Islands District, the Mission to begin on 9 June 1975 and to end as soon as practicable after the declaration of results;
2. Further decides that the Mission should be composed of _____ (Australia), _____ (France) and _____ (the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland);
3. Directs the Mission to observe the plebiscite, including the campaign and polling arrangements, the casting of votes, the closure of voting, the counting of ballots and the declaration of results;
4. Further directs the Mission, at the same time and to the extent that the primary purpose of the Mission permits, to obtain first-hand information concerning political, economic and social developments in the Mariana Islands District;
5. Requests the Mission to submit to the Trusteeship Council as soon as practicable a report on its observations of the plebiscite, containing such conclusions and recommendations as it may wish to make.
