Proposal submitted by Egypt on common elements to be included in all crimes against humanity $^{\rm l}$

- 1. The perpetrator committed an act as part of a widespread or systematic attack.
- 2. The perpetrator knew that his act was part of a widespread or systematic attack.
- 3. The widespread attack was massive, frequent, or large scale, carried out collectively with considerable seriousness and directed against a multiplicity of victims.
- 4. The systematic attack was thoroughly organized and followed a regular pattern on the basis of a common policy that was evident.
