## **Russian Federation: draft resolution**

## Human resources management

The General Assembly,

*Having considered* the relevant reports of the Secretary-General on human resources management submitted to the General Assembly<sup>1</sup> and the related reports of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>2</sup>

*Having also considered* the note by the Secretary-General drawing attention to the report of the Joint Inspection Unit on the review of mental health and well-being policies and practices in United Nations system organizations,<sup>3</sup> as well as the comments of the Secretary-General and of the United Nations System Chief Executives Board for Coordination thereon,<sup>4</sup>

1. *Takes note* of the reports of the Secretary-General;

2. *Endorses* the conclusions and recommendations contained in the reports of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions;

3. *Decides* not to amend the Staff Regulations using gender-inclusive language as proposed, and requests the Secretary-General not to use gender-inclusive language in the Staff Rules;

4. *Recognizes* the importance of accurately reflecting the work of men and women in the Staff Regulations and Rules.
