CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS BY STATES PARTIES

Periodic reports of States parties due in 2000

Note by the Secretary-General

1. In accordance with article 44, paragraph 1 (a), of the Convention on the Rights of the Child, States parties undertake to submit to the Committee on the Rights of the Child, through the Secretary-General of the United Nations, reports on the measures they have adopted which give effect to the rights recognized in the Convention and on the progress made on the enjoyment of those rights (a) within two years of the entry into force of the Convention for the State party concerned; (b) thereafter every five years.

2. Accordingly, the second periodic reports under article 44, paragraph 1 (b), of the Convention on the Rights of the Child are due in 2000 from 25 States parties on the following dates:
