Strategic Objective 1

Save lives and alleviate suffering for people affected by recurrent shocks through multi-sectoral assistance that is safe, equitable, inclusive, gender-sensitive and based on humanitarian principles.

The humanitarian context in Mali remains marked by a complex crisis stemming from a volatile security situation, exacerbated by structural vulnerability factors, socio-economic challenges and climate change.


Approximately 7.1 million people – 32 per cent of the current population – are in need of humanitarian assistance and protection. The situation is particularly severe in conflict-affected areas to the north and center of Mali, where access constraints and multiple displacements exacerbate vulnerability.

In 2024, some US\$701.6 million is required to ensure that 156 humanitarian organizations can provide critical assistance to 4.1 million people targeted in the Humanitarian Needs and Response Plan. The plan prioritizes humanitarian activities to address the urgent and life-threatening needs of the most vulnerable.



Improve inclusive and timely access to quality basic services for people affected by recurrent shocks, in line with fundamental rights and standards.




FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS: UNMET AND FUNDED (US\$) (2018-2024)



People in need, people targeted and severity by Cercle




