Resumed twenty-fourth session

AGENDA OF THE RESUMED TWENTY-FOURTH SESSION

Note by the Secretary-General

I

The Council, at its twenty-fourth session, considered items 1-17 and part of item 18 on its agenda (E/2995). Annotations to the remaining questions on its agenda, which the Council decided (E/SR.972) to consider at the resumed part of the session, are set out below. It is expected that the session will be resumed in the first half of December.

18. Elections

Under this item the Council is required to elect the seven members of the Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations. According to rule 82 of the rules of procedure of the Council, as revised at the eighteenth session, this election takes place at the resumed part of the session.

19. Confirmation of members of functional commissions of the Council

The Secretary-General will submit to the Council for confirmation the names of representatives of members of functional commissions nominated or re-nominated since the close of the twenty-third session.

20. Work of the Council in 1958

In accordance with Council resolution 557 B II (XVIII), the agenda for the resumed part of the session includes:

- (a) allocation of items to sessions of the Council during the forthcoming year on the basis of a draft programme submitted by the Secretary-General;

- (b) the disposal of items arising out of the twelfth regular session of the General Assembly; and
- (c) the establishment of dates for opening debate on items allocated to the twenty-fifth session.

II

At its 695th meeting on 1 October 1957, the General Assembly elected six members to the Economic and Social Council, for a term of office beginning on 1 January 1958. One of the six States so elected was the Sudan.

A vacancy thus arises in the membership of the Technical Assistance Committee as reconstituted by the Council in its resolution 647 (XVIII), the Sudan having been one of the States non-members of the Council elected to membership of TAC under the terms of that resolution.

In accordance with paragraph 3 of the resolution, the Council is now required to elect another State to membership of TAC for the remainder of the term of office of the Sudan, that is to say until 31 December 1958.

The Council may wish to deal with this matter under item 18 of the agenda for the resumed twenty-fourth session.
