Statement by the Department of Foreign Affairs of the Republic
of Indonesia regarding South Africa's imposition of death
sentences against six members of ANC

Jakarta, 18 December 1982. The Government of the Republic of Indonesia, bearing in mind its long-standing and consistent policy to support the struggle to eradicate apartheid, fully endorses Security Council resolution 525 (1982), which, inter alia, calls upon the Government of South Africa to withdraw the death sentences imposed upon six members of ANC. Therefore, the Government of the Republic of Indonesia, together with the international community and other international organizations, demands that the Government of South Africa immediately revoke the death sentences in the name of justice and humanity.
