LETTER DATED 13 DECEMBER 1999 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that 293 mines, bombs, missiles and other unexploded ordnance left behind by the 1991 30-Power aggression against Iraq were found and disposed of in all parts of the country between 1 October and 30 November 1999. The items included missiles, cluster bombs, munitions and anti-tank and anti-personnel mines that were found in the following governorates: Ninawa, Basrah, Karbala', Diyala, Salah al-Din, Wasit, Anbar, Dhi Qar, Najaf and Maysan.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
