Part three

IV. INTERNATIONAL POLICIES AND PROGRAMMES

Insert between paragraphs 210 and 211 the following as new paragraph 211:

"The Secretariat of all organizations with the United Nations system as well as of relevant intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations should amend their recruitment, training, promotion and remuneration policies as necessary in order to ensure equal treatment and status for men and women employed by the organizations whether as temporary, fixed-term or permanent employees or as consultants. Such organizations should, when requesting data on women's employment from Member countries with a view to publication, provide and publish comparable data on the situation as regards women's employment within the organization concerned."
