REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVES AND DEPUTY AND ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL ELECTED FOR THE PERIOD 2000-2001

At its 34th plenary meeting, on 14 October 1999, the General Assembly elected Bangladesh, Jamaica, Mali, Tunisia and Ukraine as non-permanent members of the Security Council for a term of two years beginning on 1 January 2000.

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that, with regard to the representation of the members of the Security Council elected for the period 2000-2001, he has received the communications referred to hereunder.

<u>Bangladesh</u>: Credentials from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Bangladesh, signed on 13 December 1999, stating that Mr. Anwarul Karim Chowdhury has been appointed representative of Bangladesh on the Security Council and Mr. F. A. Shamim Ahmed, Mr. Shahdat Hossain, Mr. M. Ruhul Amin and Mr. Muhammad Ali Sorcar alternate representatives.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, these credentials are in order.

<u>Jamaica</u>: Credentials from the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs and Foreign Trade of Jamaica, signed on 8 November 1999, stating that Miss M.
