## Statement by the Government of Mali

The Government of the Republic of Mali strongly condemns the military <a href="coup d'état">coup d'état</a> that occurred in the Republic of Côte d'Ivoire on Friday, 24 December 1999.

Reaffirming its opposition to the taking of power by force, which is a break with the democratic process and republican legality, the Government of Mali calls upon those who carried out the  $\underline{\text{coup d'\'etat}}$  to return to constitutional legality.

In view of the major crisis which that fraternal country is undergoing, the people and Government of Mali reiterate their strong solidarity with the fraternal people of Côte d'Ivoire and express their determination to support all efforts aimed at establishing, in peace and dialogue, the conditions of republican and democratic legality, to which the Ivorian people and all our peoples aspire.
