Report of the Office of Internal Oversight Services on the triennial review of the implementation of recommendations on the inspection of the evaluation function of the United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women (UN-Women)

1. At its 6th meeting, on 15 May 2024, the Committee considered the report of OIOS on the triennial review of the implementation of recommendations made by the Committee at its sixty-first session on the inspection of the evaluation function of the United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women (UN-Women) ([E/AC.51/2024/4](#)).

Discussion

2. Several delegations expressed appreciation for the report. A delegation noted that, with regard to recommendation 2, relating to improved delivery and utility of corporate evaluations, UN-Women should ensure that the Corporate Evaluation Plan reflected the needs of the organization and that corporate evaluations were timely. The importance of formative and more forward-looking evaluations was noted. Another delegation said that it was important for UN-Women to improve how it measured the timeliness of evaluation reports, expressing support for the need for consistent onboarding and training, as well as capacity-building, of monitoring and evaluation officers.

Conclusions and recommendations

3. **The Committee recommended that the General Assembly take note of the report of OIOS on the triennial review of the implementation of the recommendations made by the Committee on the inspection of the evaluation function of UN-Women and expressed its appreciation to OIOS for the convened review.**
