EIGHTH UNITED NATIONS TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE CONFERENCE

FINAL ACT OF THE EIGHTH UNITED NATIONS TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE CONFERENCE

 At the request of the Negotiating Committee for Extra-Budgetary Funds, the Secretary-General, by a letter to the permanent delegations of Member States and to the representatives of non-Member States, dated 2 July 1957, convened the Eighth United Nations Technical Assistance Conference, at which Governments were asked to announce their contributions to the Expanded Programme of Technical Assistance for the eighth financial period, 1 January-31 December 1958.
The Eighth United Nations Technical Assistance Conference met at Headquarters on 10 October 1957. The Governments of the following States were represented at the Conference by delegations:

The Conference requested the Secretary-General to communicate to the Governments invited to the Conference the additional amounts announced by Governments notified to him after the close of the Conference.

New York, this 10th day of October 1957, in a single copy in the English, French and Spanish languages, each text being The original will be deposited with the Secretary-General equally authentic. of the United Nations who will send certified copies to each of the Governments invited to send representatives to the Conference.
