#### Addendum

#### PART II OF SCHEDULE I

- 1. This document, which is published in each of the four languages of the Conference, reproduces, by photo-offset from the signature copy of the Agreement Establishing the International Fund for Agricultural Development, the respective one of the four authoritative versions (Arabic, English, French and Spanish) of the final text of Part II of Schedule I of the Agreement\* recording the pledges of initial contributions to the Fund by States eligible for original membership, made either before or at the Conference (as recorded in A/CONF.73/15/Add.1) or subsequently communicated to the Secretary-General of the United Nations pursuant to a resolution adopted by the Conference (A/CONF.73/16) until 20 December 1976, the day on which the Agreement was opened for signature in accordance with its Article 13, Section 1 (a).
- 2. The text of the Agreement, including the two Schedules that form an integral part thereof, except for Part II of Schedule I, was published in the four languages of the Conference in document A/CONF.73/15, which has already been distributed. That document consists of a photo-offset reproduction of the respective one of the four authoritative language versions of the single original text of the Agreement that was initialled at the conclusion of the Conference and now constitutes the signature copy.
