I have the honour to refer to General Assembly resolution 74/303 of 4 September 2020, entitled, “*Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly*”, by which the Assembly decided to establish, at its seventy-fifth session, an Ad Hoc Working Group on the revitalization of the work of the General Assembly.

In this regard, I have the pleasure to inform you that I have reappointed H.E. Mr. Michal Mlynár, Permanent Representative of Slovakia and appointed H.E. Ms. Egriselda Aracely González López, Permanent Representative of El Salvador as co-chairs of the Ad Hoc Working Group on the Revitalization of the Work of the General Assembly during the seventy-fifth session.

The work of the Ad Hoc Working Group remains vital in enhancing the role, authority, effectiveness and efficiency of the General Assembly. Resolution 74/303 requested the Secretary-General to undertake an analysis of the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the work of the General Assembly and to brief the Ad Hoc Working Group this session. This will be an important opportunity to review how the General Assembly has adapted its working methods to continue to address evolving global challenges.

I would like to thank Ambassador Mlynár and Ambassador López for having accepted this very important responsibility. I trust that you will extend your full support and cooperation to them throughout the process.
