*Draft resolution A/C.4/78/L.17: Comprehensive review of the whole question of peacekeeping operations in all their aspects*

1. **Mr. Eldahshan** (Egypt), Rapporteur of the Special Committee on Peacekeeping Operations, introducing the report of the Special Committee on Peacekeeping Operations on its 2024 substantive session (A/78/19), said that the Special Committee had met from 19 February to 15 March 2024. The Working Group of the Whole had convened briefings on 21 February and met from 22 February to 15 March to discuss and finalize the proposals, recommendations and conclusions of the Special Committee.
2. Introducing the draft resolution, he said that it was based on similar resolutions adopted in recent years. Revisions had been made to take account of the agreement that had been reached on conclusions and recommendations.
3. **The Chair** said that the draft resolution had no programme budget implications.
4. *Draft resolution A/C.4/78/L.17 was adopted.*
