### **Review of the efficiency of the administrative and financial functioning of the United Nations**

#### **Report of the Fifth Committee**

#### **I. Introduction**

1. The previous recommendations made by the Fifth Committee to the General Assembly under agenda item 118 appear in the report of the Committee contained in document A/54/511.
2. The Fifth Committee resumed its consideration of the item at its 50th meeting on 23 December 1999. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/54/SR.50).

#### **II. Consideration of draft decisions A/C.5/54/L.37 and A/C.5/54/L.38**

##### **A. Draft decision A/C.5/54/L.37**

3. At the 50th meeting, on 23 December, the Committee had before it a draft decision submitted by the Chairman entitled "Action taken on certain items" (A/C.5/54/L.37).
