DRAFT PROGRAMME OF ACTION FOR THE SECOND HALF
OF THE UNITED NATIONS DECADE FOR WOMEN
(A/CONF.94/22 and Corr.1)

Amendments submitted by Bulgaria

1. Replace the last sentence in paragraph 25 by the following:

The struggle to put an end to the aggressive and oppressive policies of imperialism, colonialism and neo-colonialism, to achieve peace and détente, to curb the arms race, to obtain freedom, social progress and peaceful international co-operation on the basis of equal rights and mutual respect for national independence and sovereignty, and for non-interference in internal affairs, constitutes the all-important factor which provides the conditions to move forward with the implementation of the other two objectives of the Decade.

2. Add a new paragraph after paragraph 26, which will read as follows:

Women have and can play an active role in the efforts of the international community to protect détente and to make it a continuing and universal process of an all-embracing scope by helping the endeavour to broaden the roads of co-operation and to build new roads for the future.
