DRAFT PROGRAMME OF ACTION FOR THE SECOND HALF OF THE UNITED NATIONS DECADE FOR WOMEN (A/CONF.94/22 and Corr.1)

Amendments submitted by New Zealand

Add the following text to paragraph 11:

"However it can be said that existing theories of labour and capital do not adequately trace the linkages between women's work both in the reproductive and productive sectors, and production systems in world economies. Similarly the understood histories of subjection, colonialism, oppression and domination among States do not adequately trace the subjection, colonialism, oppression and domination of women by men, not simply discriminated against by the productive systems, but subject to the discrimination that arises by virtue of being the reproductive force."
