APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS AND OTHER APPOINTMENTS

Confirmation of the appointment of the Secretary-General of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development

Note by the Secretary-General

1. Section II, paragraph 27, of General Assembly resolution 1995 (XIX) of 30 December 1964 provides that the Secretary-General of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development shall be appointed by the Secretary-General of the United Nations and that his appointment shall be confirmed by the Assembly.
2. The present term of Mr. Gamani Corea as Secretary-General of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development expires on 31 March 1983 (decision 34/321).
3. In accordance with the terms of the above resolution, the Secretary-General proposes that the appointment of Mr. Corea be extended for a further period of one year and nine months, beginning on 1 April 1983 and ending on 31 December 1984. The Secretary-General wishes to state that this recommendation is being made after consultation with Mr. Corea.
4. The Secretary-General expresses the hope that the General Assembly will confirm this extension of appointment.
