LETTER FROM THE DELEGATION OF ECUADOR
TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL

"The Delegation of Ecuador, being particularly anxious that the problem of the equitable adjustment of prices on the international market be studied at the forthcoming Conference on International Trade and Employment to be called by the Economic and Social Council, in pursuance of the recommendation of Supplementary Rule T of the Provisional Rules of Procedure of the General Assembly, asked that the said Supplementary Rule be extended to include within its scope the 'equitable adjustment of prices on the international market.'

"The General Assembly in its Plenary Meeting of 28 January last decided to adopt the proposal of Ecuador, and, amongst other Delegations, the Delegations of the following countries represented on the Economic and Social Council voted in favour of the proposal: Belgium, Canada, Chile, China, Colombia, Cuba, Czechoslovakia, France, Greece, India, Lebanon, Peru, USSR, Ukraine, United Kingdom; Norway abstaining.

"In view of the foregoing, the Delegation of Ecuador requests that the Economic and Social Council, when it decides to call an International Conference on Trade and Employment, should at the same time decide that the said Conference should also study the problem of the 'equitable adjustment of prices on the international market' in accordance with the resolution adopted by the General Assembly allowing the amendment proposed by the Delegation of Ecuador to stand.

"The Delegation of Ecuador further requests that it be permitted to take part, without the right to vote, in the deliberations of the Council regarding this matter in which it is particularly interested such participation being in accordance with Article 69 of the Charter of the United Nations. For this purpose, Dr. Antonio Parra Velasco, Delegate, has been appointed representative of Ecuador.
