PROPOSAL CONCERNING THE TERMS OF REFERENCE OF THE ECONOMIC
AND EMPLOYMENT COMMISSION IN CONNECTION WITH THE
RESOLUTION REGARDING THE TRADE
CONFERENCES

The Representative for the United Kingdom gives notice of its intention to propose to the Economic and Social Council the following resolution, arising out of the resolution regarding the International Conference on Trade and Employment as soon as the latter resolution has been passed by the Council.

"In view of its decision to sponsor an International Conference on Trade and Employment, having as one of the principal items on its Agenda an international agreement on the maintenance of high and stable levels of employment and economic activity,

THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL

Instructs the Economic and Employment Commission to give early consideration to the most appropriate form which the international agreement on the maintenance of high and stable levels of employment and economic activity might take, having regard to the relevant section of the proposals put forward by the United States for consideration by the Conference, and to report its observations to the next Session of the Council with a view to their transmission to the Preparatory Committee of the Conference".
