رسالة مؤرخة 27 آب/أغسطس 2024 موجهة إلى الأمين العام من الممثلة الدائمة  
لقبرص لدى الأمم المتحدة

بناء على تعليمات من حكومة بلدي، أحيل إليكم طيه 32 مرفقا منفصلا تسجل انتهاكات المجال الجوي الوطني لقبرص، وأنظمة الحركة الجوية الدولية داخل منطقة معلومات الطيران لقبرص، والمياه الإقليمية لقبرص، والاستخدام غير القانوني للموانئ والمطارات المغلقة في قبرص، من قبل القوات الجوية والبحرية لتركيا، في الفترة من آذار/مارس 2023 إلى حزيران/يونيه 2024.

وقد لوحظ وقوع 2 120 انتهاكاً جويًا و 137 انتهاكاً بحرياً خلال هذه الفترة. وتجدر الإشارة إلى أن 639 من الانتهاكات الجوية الـ 2 120 كانت تتعلق باستخدام مركبات جوية عسكرية غير مأهولة تركية. وعلاوة على ذلك، أجرت تركيا مناورات عسكرية انتهكت المجال الجوي لجمهورية قبرص، وأصدرت بشأنها بصورة غير قانونية 12 تنبيهًا للطيارين ورسالتين من رسائل الملاحة البحرية النصية.

ولا تشكل الانتهاكات المستمرة للوضع العسكري الراهن في الجزيرة والتوغلات شبه اليومية في المنطقة العازلة، التي يفاقمها التحديث المستمر للبنية التحتية العسكرية في المناطق المحتلة المعسكرة بشكل كثيف أصلاً، إلا جزءاً ضئيلاً من سلوك تركيا العدواني باستمرار في قبرص. وتهدف الانتهاكات/عمليات التقدم العسكرية العديدة التي تقوم بها قوات الاحتلال التركي إلى خلق أمر واقع جديد وتقويض شعور الشعب بالأمن وكذلك الجهود المبذولة لاستئناف المفاوضات. وتكشف هذه الأعمال عن نوايا أنقرة في إدامة احتلالها وتطوي على مخاطر جسيمة ليس فقط على أمن قبرص، وسيادتها وسلامة أراضيها، ولكن أيضاً على أمن واستقرار منطقة شرق البحر الأبيض المتوسط الأوسع نطاقاً.

ويصادف هذا العام مرور 50 عاماً على استمرار الاحتلال التركي غير القانوني في قبرص. ويكمن هذا الانتهاك لسيادة جمهورية قبرص وسلامة أراضيها والعواقب المأساوية التي تترتب عليه بالنسبة إلى جزيرتنا وشعبها في صميم الوضع الراهن غير المقبول وغير المستدام الذي تُدعى اليوم إلى تجاوزه.



غير أن تركيا تقوم، بوصفها الجهة الغازية والقوة المحتلة في قبرص، بتكثيف جهودها لفرض "حل يقوم على دولتين" في الجزيرة. وبتابع نهج انتقائي إزاء قرارات مجلس الأمن، تختار تركيا وصف هذه القرارات بأنها قرارات فات أوانها عندما لا تتوافق مع خطابها وتدعو المجتمع الدولي إلى "مواجهة الحقائق على الأرض"، في محاولة لإقناعه بأن نتيجة عدوانها هي نتيجة سلمية من الناحية القانونية.

وتشكل أعمال تركيا العدوانية وخطابها العدواني عاملاً مزعماً للاستقرار على أرض الواقع في قبرص، وكذلك في المنطقة الأوسع نطاقاً. ويدل الانتهاك المستمر لسلامة أراضي قبرص وسيادتها، وبالتالي لميثاق الأمم المتحدة، على ازدياد تركيا الصارخ للقانون الدولي. ويتضح ذلك بشكل خاص في حالة فاروشا، حيث تستمر أعمال التحويل غير القانوني للمنطقة المسيجة بلا هوادة، على الرغم من الدعوة الواضحة التي وجهها مجلس الأمن (انظر S/PRST/2021/13) إلى الجانب التركي للكف والعدول عن انتهاكات الوضع الراهن، وحيث تحدث هذه الأعمال في تجاهل تام لقرار مجلس الأمن 550 (1984)، الذي يدعو المجلس فيه إلى إعادة فاروشا إلى سكانها الشرعيين ونقل المنطقة إلى إدارة الأمم المتحدة.

وفي السياق الجيوسياسي العالمي الحالي، يتحتم على الأمم المتحدة أن تثبت عدم وجود معايير مزدوجة في تطبيق الميثاق. ويجب الدفاع عن سيادة الدول التي تتعرض للهجوم وعن سلامتها الإقليمية، بغض النظر عن مصدر الهجمات أو طول الفترة التي تنقضي عليها. وهذا صحيح بالتأكيد في حالة قبرص، حيث لا تزال المشكلة هي مشكلة غزو عسكري واحتلال غير قانوني مستمر. والوضع الذي خلقته تركيا في قبرص، من خلال استخدام القوة والانتهاكات المستمرة لحقوق الإنسان والشرعية الدولية، هو ما تعنيه حقاً عبارة "الحقائق على الأرض": فذلك هو الموضوع الذي أصبح فيه انتهاكات الميثاق وقرارات مجلس الأمن هي القاعدة. وهذا هو تحديد السبب الذي يجب من أجله أن يدعم مجلس الأمن قراراته هو نفسه ويحرص على أن تكون ذات مغزى؛ وما لم يحدث ذلك، فإن مصداقية النظام الدولي تقوِّض بشدة.

ونحن نمر حالياً بفترة حساسة وصعبة للغاية. وقد كان تعيين ماريا أنخيل هولغوين كويبار في كانون الثاني/يناير الماضي مبعوثة شخصية لكم تطوراً مرحباً به طال انتظاره وهو أعطى زخماً متجدداً للجهود الرامية إلى استئناف المفاوضات. ومما يؤسف له أن هذا الجهد لا يزال يقوِّض حتى الآن بإصرار الجانب التركي على مواقف بعيدة تماماً عن المعايير التي وضعتها الأمم المتحدة فيما يتعلق بحل مشكلة قبرص. وفي الوقت نفسه، يتجلى هذا الموقف غير المقبول بشكل متزايد في الأعمال الاستفزازية على الأرض في قبرص، وكذلك من خلال الجهود المكثفة لتعزيز عملية رفع المكانة الدولية للكيان الانفصالي.

ولا تزال جمهورية قبرص ملتزمة بالأساس الذي أقرته الأمم المتحدة لحل مشكلة قبرص كاتحاد ثنائي الطائفة بين منطقتين يقوم على المساواة السياسية، على النحو المنصوص عليه في قرارات مجلس الأمن، على الرغم من العقوبات التي تضعها أمانا تركيا والإدارة المحلية التابعة لها. ويشكل هذا الإطار المتفق عليه السبيل الوحيد القابل للتطبيق للمضي قدماً في سياق الجهود الرامية إلى حل مشكلة قبرص، وفي هذا الصدد، تعترم حكومة جمهورية قبرص بذل كل جهد ممكن بالتعاون معكم لتهيئة الظروف الملائمة للعودة إلى المفاوضات، بهدف إعادة توحيد قبرص وشعبها، على أساس قرارات مجلس الأمن ذات الصلة.

وأرجو ممتنة تعميم هذه الرسالة ومرفقاتها باعتبارها وثيقة رسمية من وثائق الجمعية العامة، في إطار البند 40 من جدول الأعمال، ومن وثائق مجلس الأمن.
