

## Annex to the letter dated 22 October 2024 from the Permanent Representative of Haiti to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

On behalf of the Haitian people, I would like to offer you my warmest thanks for your latest report on the situation in Haiti, and in particular for your address to the Security Council on Monday 30 September 2024, when the Council adopted resolution 2751 (2024) extending the mandate of the Multinational Security Support Mission in Haiti for a further year.

I would also like to highlight the leadership of the President of Kenya, William Ruto, and of the Governments of the contributing States, which have allowed the deployment of part of the Mission contingent in support of the efforts of the Haitian National Police since 25 June. Since its arrival, several joint operations have been carried out with positive results. However, I must emphasize that there are still enormous challenges to address if the Haitian people are to be able to go about their business freely.

On Thursday 26 September, my colleague, Presidential Council member Edgard Leblanc Fils, in his address during the general debate of the seventy-ninth session of the General Assembly, explained those challenges and also proposed the transformation of the Multinational Security Support Mission into a United Nations peacekeeping mission, which would result in more funding and a broader mandate.

In view of the urgency of the situation, I am hereby requesting that the Multinational Security Support Mission be transformed into a peacekeeping mission as soon as possible.
