Open-ended Working Group set up by the Commission on Human Rights to consider the drafting of a declaration on the rights of persons belonging to national, ethnic, religious and linguistic minorities

Proposals relating to articles 1, 2, 3, 5 and 6 of the draft declaration, made by the following countries: Australia, Bulgaria, China, India and the United States of America.

# Australia

Article 2 (of the revised draft declaration contained in document E/CN.4/Sub.2/L.734) In the third line replace the word "characteristics" by the word "identity".

### Bulgaria

# New article 1

"l. Paragraph 1:

Persons belonging to [national or] ethnic, religious or linguistic minorities (hereinafter referred to as persons belonging to minorities) have the right to life, liberty and security of person; to equality before the law; to respect for their [national or] ethnic, religious or linguistic identity; to enjoy their own culture; to profess and practise their own religion; or to use their own language.

Persons belonging to minorities shall enjoy equal human rights and fundamental freedoms without any discrimination as to [national or] ethnic origin, religion or language with the rest of the population of the States in which such minorities exist."

#### China

Article 3 (of the revised draft declaration contained in document E/CN.4/Sub.2/L.734)
Add the following sentence at the end of paragraph 3:

"These contacts and activities should be within the limits of the laws of the countries in which they live."

# India

# Article 1 (new draft proposed by Bulgaria)

In the second line of paragraph 2 add the word "negative" between the words "any" and "discrimination".

Article 6 (of the revised draft declaration contained in document E/CN.4/Sub.2/L.734)

In the second line, replace the word "conditions" by the word "resources".

United States of America

Article 5 (of the revised draft declaration contained in document E/CN.4/Sub.2/L.734)

In the second line of paragraph 1, replace the word "non-interference" by the word "non-intervention".
