

Letter dated 29 November 2024 from the President of the Security Council addressed to the Secretary-General

The Security Council has expressed deep concern at the current multidimensional political, security, economic and humanitarian crisis in Haiti and also taken note of the letter dated 21 October 2024 from the President of the Transitional Presidential Council of Haiti addressed to the Secretary-General (S/2024/765, annex).

The members of the Security Council request you to provide, for their consideration, within the next 60 to 90 days and in consultation with all relevant Haitian stakeholders, the Multinational Security Support Mission, regional and international stakeholders, including Council members, the United Nations Integrated Office in Haiti and the United Nations country team in Haiti, a comprehensive assessment of the current Haiti context and ongoing United Nations and international efforts, together with strategic-level recommendations with a full range of options for the possible role that the United Nations can play in this regard, incorporating lessons learned from previous United Nations missions, political developments in Haiti and the current Multinational Security Support Mission, with a view to a long-term perspective to sustain security and stability in Haiti, addressing the root causes of the crisis.
