LETTER DATED 3 FEBRUARY 2000 FROM THE PERMANENT
REPRESENTATIVE OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA TO THE
UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to inform you that the delegation of religious leaders from Kosovo comprising Dr. Rexhep Bojaj, Mufti and President, Islamic Community of Kosovo; Mr. Qemajl Morina, Vice-Dean, Faculty of Islamic Studies; H.E. Artemije Radosavljevic, Bishop of Raska-Prizren, Serbian Orthodox Church, Father Justin (Milan) Jezdic, Msgr. Marko Sopi, Bishop, Diocese of Prizren, and Don Shan Zefi, Vicar General, Diocese of Prizren; will be visiting Bosnia and Herzegovina from 7 to 9 February 2000 on a mission of peace and reconciliation at the invitation of the Inter-Religious Council of Bosnia and Herzegovina. During their visit, the religious leaders of Kosovo will have working meetings with the Inter-Religious Council of Bosnia and Herzegovina to consider the situation in, and possible solutions to the issue of, Kosovo. The early fruit of the work of the Inter-Religious Council of Bosnia and Herzegovina in promoting tolerance and reconciliation in our country is hoped to have a similar impact also in Kosovo.

May I ask for your kind assistance in circulating this letter as a document of the Security Council.
